Join us to to develop open source Earth technology for climate accountability.

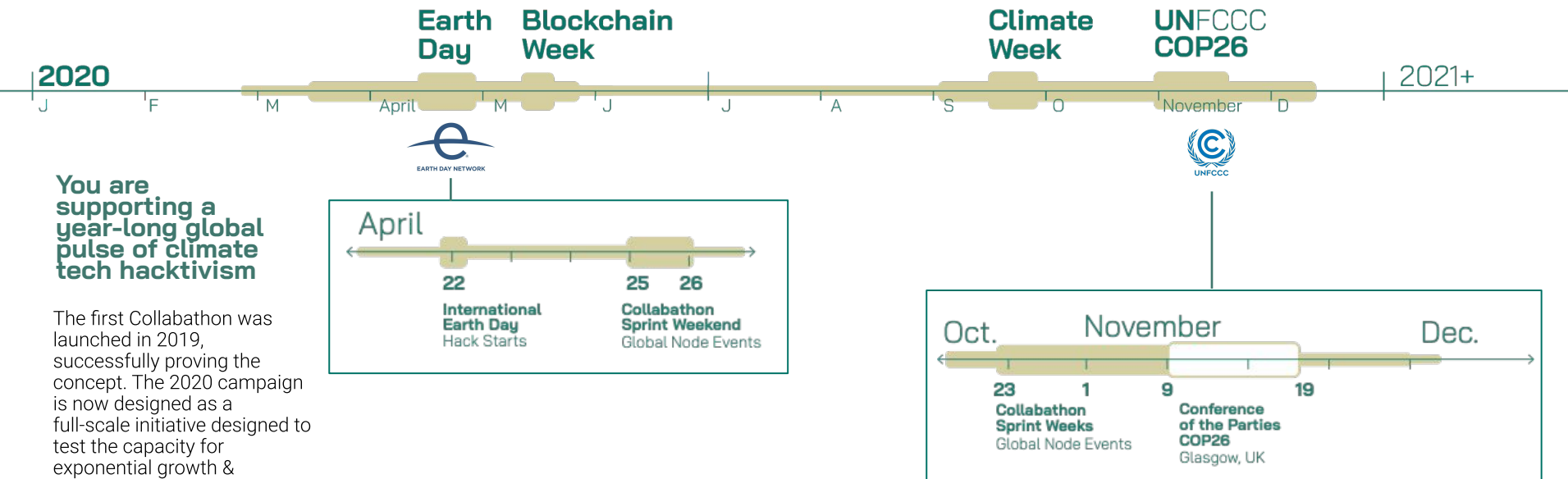

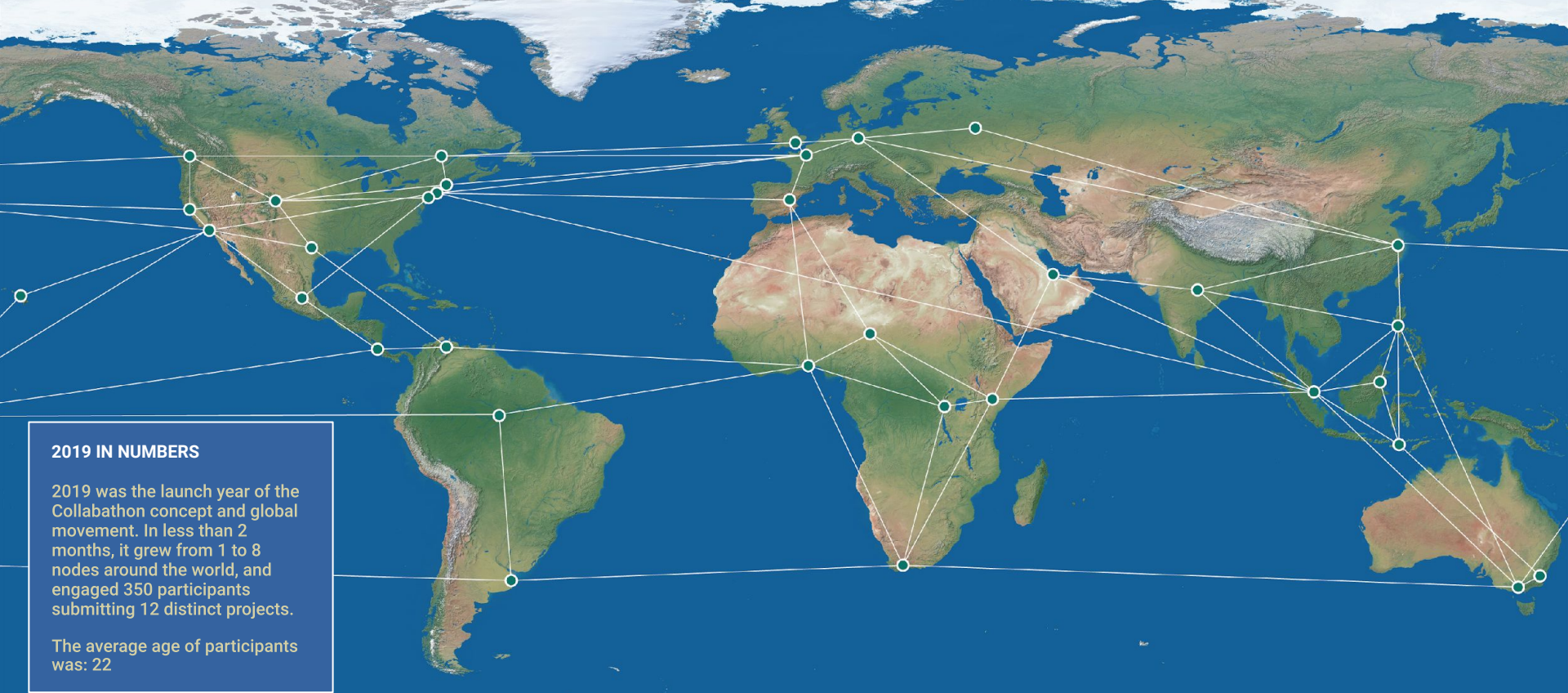

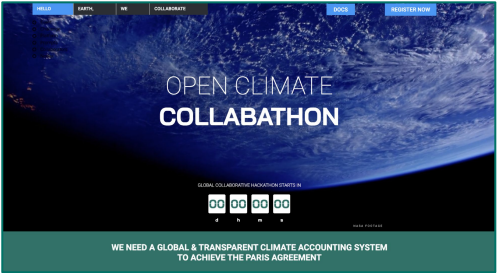

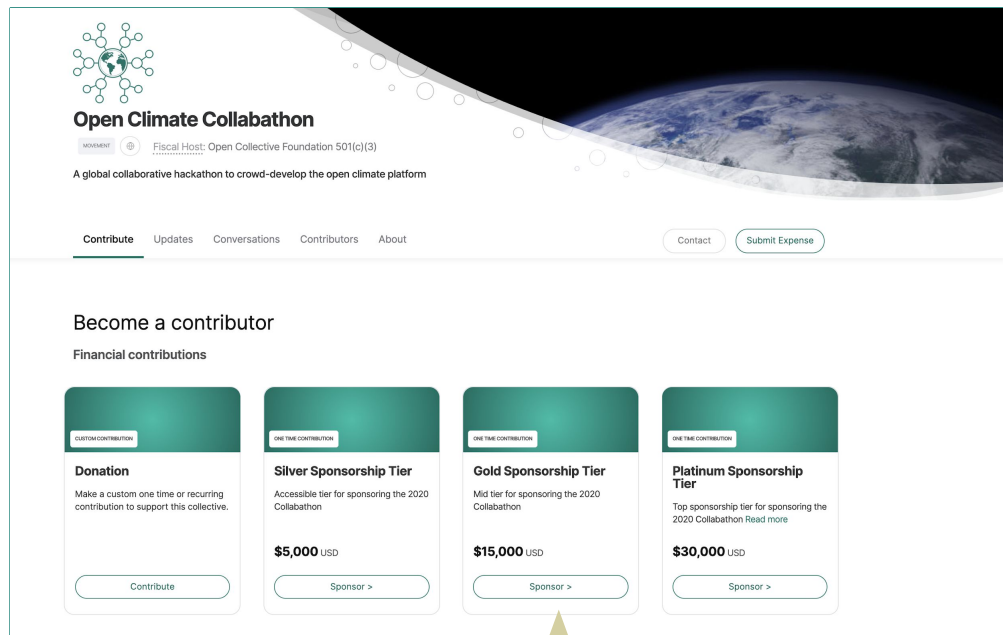


The 2020 Open Climate Collabathon is an open collective. It is fiscally hosted by the Open Collective Foundation and its finances are transparently visible to the community.

HOW TO SPONSOR

PARTNERSHIP PHILOSOPHY

We see sponsors as partners that are joining us on a collective journey to do something different and meaningful.

Is the Collabathon a non-profit initiative?

YES. Sponsorship funds are used to cover event costs and no surplus is retained by individuals or organizations.

Are sponsorship funds tax exempt?

YES. Your sponsorship funds are received by the Open Collective Foundation, a California-based 501 (c)(3) charity

Do I get an invoice for my contribution?

YES. Once you submit your sponsorship funds, you will receive an invoice from the Open Collective Foundation which can be used for your accounting purposes

What are the 'Earth tier' donations used for?

These donations are used to create an experimental fund that uses decentralized governance to support community developments.

SPONSORSHIP RULES

We have adopted similar sponsorship rules as TED™.

- Sponsors are encouraged to contribute ideas, source new nodes, participants and other sponsors, and provide subject-matter expertise when applicable.
- Sponsors, however, have no editorial control or veto power over the collabathon program and prompts.
- Sponsors have no control over the publishing open source licenses of the crowd-developed work.
- Sponsors have no direct control on the use of proceeds.
- Sponsor's unrelated products/services may not be promoted directly on collabathon's social media, only be recognized for their support.
- Sponsor logos may only be shown at either the start and end of each official video for a maximum of 3 seconds.
- Sponsor logos or names should appear on a dedicated website page to sponsors.
- Sponsor businesses cannot fall under the following industries: Adult-oriented products/services, Tobacco/cigarettes, Weapons, ammunitions and defense.
